NBAA House Rules Amendments - Article 7.18.A & 7.18.B & 7.18.C & 7.18.D

The following changes was already discussed at the NBAA AGM of the 24th of November 2015, however the changes has not been made on the House Rules. The changes will be done in 2017, the proposed changes as minute in the AGM Minutes of the 24th of November 2015 was as follow:

Proposed Change (Additions):

7.18.A.2. c) If, by using the prescribed ratios to calculate the scores, anglers are tied on points then the angler that caught the biggest bag weight during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler. If the heaviest bag weights result in another tie then the angler that caught the heaviest fish during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler.

7.18.B.2. c) If, by using the prescribed ratios to calculate the scores, anglers are tied on points then the angler that caught the biggest bag weight during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler. If the heaviest bag weights result in another tie then the angler that caught the heaviest fish during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler.

7.18.C.2. c) If, by using the prescribed ratios to calculate the scores, anglers are tied on points then the angler that caught the biggest bag weight during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler. If the heaviest bag weights result in another tie then the angler that caught the heaviest fish during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler.

7.18.D.2. c) If, by using the prescribed ratios to calculate the scores, anglers are tied on points then the angler that caught the biggest bag weight during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler. If the heaviest bag weights result in another tie then the angler that caught the heaviest fish during a NBAA sanctioned tournament in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler.

It was proposed that the wording be changed from 'NBAA sanctioned tournament' to 'all eight (8) competitions.

Thus the changes will be as follow for 7.18.A.2, 7.18.B.2, 7.18.C.2 & 7.18.D.2:

7.18.A.2. c) If, by using the prescribed ratios to calculate the scores, anglers are tied on points then the angler that caught the biggest bag out of all eight (8) competitions in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler. If the heaviest bag weights result in another tie then the angler that caught the heaviest fish during the NBAA eight (8) tournaments in the same calendar year will be selected ahead of the other angler. The eight (8) tournaments include National Tournaments, National Championships (trials) and the B.A.S.S. National Qualifier event.

Motion carried. Proposed by J Coetzee, seconded by M Goosen and unanimously accepted by all.

9.2 Motion to change Annexure 12, 4.4 Starting

The Tournament Director will determine the starting and end time of all angling competitions two (2) weeks prior to any competition and all anglers will be notified of times. All factors including safe travel to and from a venue will be taken into account when determining the times. The change will be beneficial considering that we have seasonal time changes in Namibia.

A random generator program will be used to determine starting position of anglers and this will be done by the NBAA secretary, Collette Carstens. The starting position list will be send out on the Monday or by the latest Tuesday during the week of the competition.

The national selection committee may utilize an angler's merit, in determining candidates for a team.

Merit selection can be based on but not limited to the following criteria:

Past performance in NBAA team events such as for example:

Individual performance at Region 5 level, going back a maximum of 5 calendar years.

Individual performance at Presidents level, going back a maximum of 5 calendar years,

Individual performance at Non-National Team level, going back a maximum of 5 calendar years, Individual performance at CIPS / FIPSed Black Bass World Championship level, going back a maximum of 5 calendar years.

Active participation in NBAA Development and NBAA Fund Raiser Events within the last year e.g. Golf Days, Corporate Bass Challenges and other development events, etc.

A merit point system will be determined by EXCO and the Selection Committee for the President's Team.

Any and all changes need to be made to the Constitution, Annexures and House Rules once the merit point system has been determined by EXCO.

The region 5 Namibian Bass Angling Team Commitment (Annexure17) will be added to the constitution.

Motion carried unanimously and mandate given to EXCO to determine merit point system.

10.8 Amend article 8.9 National Selectors meetings

Article 8.9.1. currently reads:

The national selectors committee shall be called upon at any such time by the chairman, or in his absence the nominated chief selector to address any matters relating to the selection of the national teams.
