Public Relations Officer Report 2020

It has been an extremely difficult year for the NBAA, its member's, and the Namibian economy. We have had to cancel many of our tournaments for 2020 due to the COVID-19 lockdown rules.

With challenges also come opportunities, and the NBAA hosted its very first online tournament using the Keepnet app. This enabled anglers to compete while still adhering to strict lockdown rules. The Cymot iBass tournament trial was hosted over a period of 3 months where anglers could go out and fish on their own, weighing their catches in online with the app. The tournament was a great success and has presented us with a new way of fishing competitively.

There was not much publicity or promotion from a PRO perspective for the NBAA during the lockdown period and thus I present you with a very shortened version this year.

We make use of the various platforms to create awareness and share information with our members and fellow bass anglers, give some brand awareness and recognition to our sponsors and promote the sport of bass fishing in Namibia.

Newspaper Articles: The newspaper articles are used to publish information of the national competitions, make public announcements, announce the national team, give recognition and exposure to the sponsors and advertise planned events. The NBAA published various newspaper articles during 2020, most of them in the Republikein and Namibian newspaper.


Radio Advertising: Radiowave sponsors airtime to the NBAA to promote special events and raise awareness of the NBAA.



Facebook Statistics




Likes have increased from 1409 to a total of 1487 during 2020


